

# **Argon's Home**



He wore a crisp white lab coat with the Tennessee tri-star badge. His golden fur shone under the lab lights, and his tail wagged every time an experiment began.




## **Argon's Motto**

Argon had a special motto:


"Science is for everyone—especially if you have paws!"
